Wolf Henzler is a German racing driver known for his impressive success with Porsches. He began racing in 1991 with a win in the German Junior Kart championship.

Wolf is one of nine Porsche factory race drivers. He currently drives for Team Falken Tire in the American Le Mans Series with co-driver Bryan Sellers, and competes on the Rolex Grand Am GT Class in a Porsche 911 GT3 for Team TRG, which came in first in 2011 and second in 2012 in the 24 Hours of Daytona.

For several years, he has competed in the prestigious 24 Hours of LeMans for Farnbacher-Proton.

In 2010 he and co-drivers, Marc Lieb and Richard Lietz, won in their Porsche 997 GT3 RSR, and came in fourth in 2011.

Additionally, in 2010, he scored a victory in the 24 Hours of Spa and a first place finish in the FIA GT2 European Cup in a Porsche 911 GT3 RSR for Team BMS Scuderia.

In 2011, he drove a Porsche 911 GT3 RSR to two wins for Team Falken Tire, at the Mid-Ohio Sports Car Course and the inaugural Baltimore Grand Prix, in the American Le Mans Series with co-drivers Patrick Pilet and Bryan Sellers. Also in 2011, he took first place in the NASA 25 hours of Thunderhill in a Porsche 911 GT3 Cup for Team Scott Mercer Motorsports.

His has also scored a championship win in the GT2 class in the 12 hours of Sebring.

Aside from competition, Henzler has scored two Masters Degrees in Business Economics and Computer Science.
